Accessible via an app, a VPN allows a device to bypass security measures and network restrictions implemented by our school and the Department of Education. Such limitations are put in place to protect students from harmful, inappropriate and irrelevant material on the internet, as well as protect our school’s network and the security of personal information from cyber-attacks and malicious content.
